She has actively participated in music scenes in North America and Europe, as an avid live performer as well as an Independent recording artist and session vocalist.

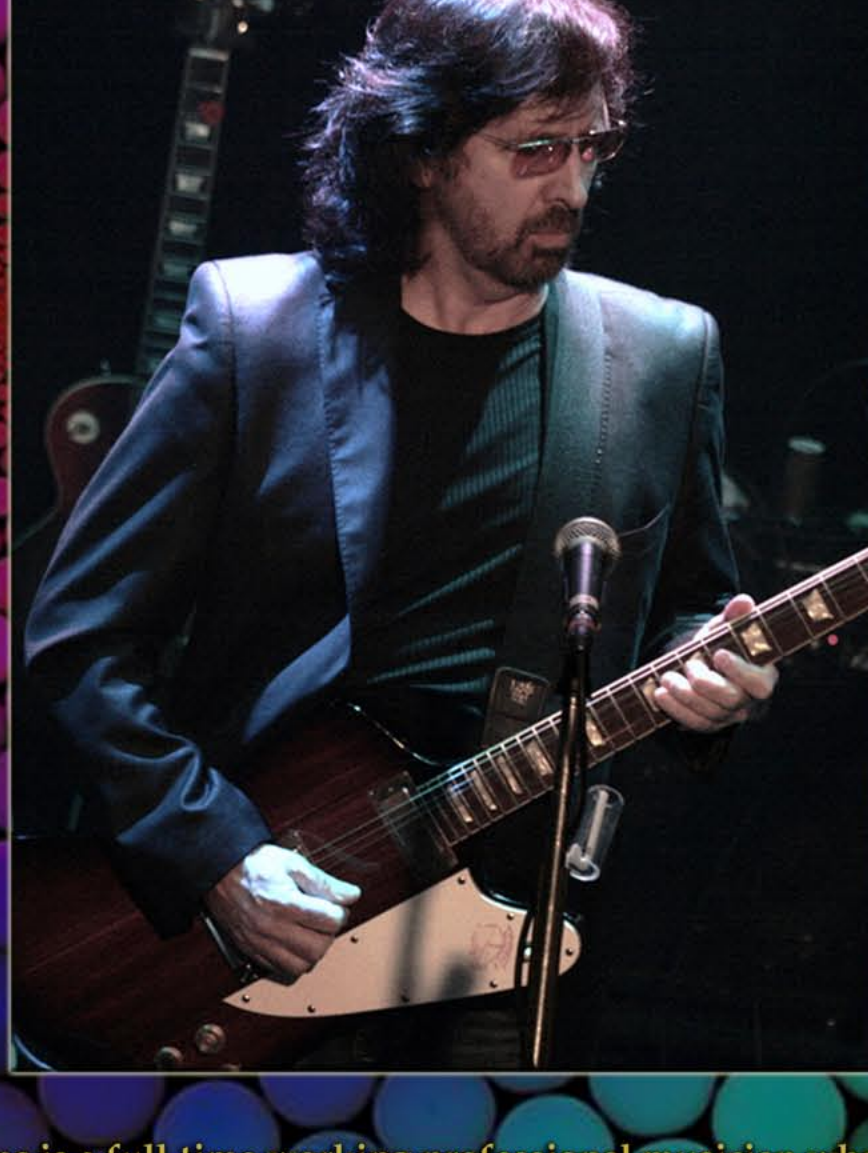
Impeccably delivering both heart wrenching ballads and powerhouse rock n roll, Bouza is a versatile and soulful performer, described by one critic as
